The first round of matches may be pool play depending on the number of registered teams. Teams can expect to play at least five (5) games.

A complete format of schedule will be published after registration.

Registration Fee is \$150.00US per team, to be paid before October 31, 2010. There is a late registration fee of \$25.00US after deadline.

A Performance Bond of \$25.00US must accompany registration fee. This will be returned once your team reports on time for games, Opening Ceremony and not forfeiting any game.

Registration form should be completed and returned to the CPTSA before November 6, 2010.

Overseas teams should contact the CPTSA about accommodation, as soon as possible. Ground transportation will be provided.
